

## **WA Child Research Fund 2018 (Round 7)**

### ***formerly Telethon-Perth Children's Hospital Research Fund (TPCHRF)***

**Call for Applications - Closing Date: 1:00pm, Wednesday 20 February 2018**

The WA Child Research Fund (formerly the Telethon-Perth Children's Hospital Research Fund; TPCHRF) was established by the Department of Health and Channel 7 Telethon Trust to provide funding for research activities that focus on child and adolescent health in Western Australia

Funded research activities may be wide-ranging but must address areas of direct significance to child and adolescent health. Research may include basic, clinical, health service, or population health research.

In addition, for this year, priority areas for funding have been nominated. These include:

1. WA Health led research;
2. Projects that utilise and collaborate with past TPCHRF Stream 2 Strategic Research initiatives; and
3. Targeted research to address the research needs of the [WA Youth Health Policy](#).

Researchers considering applying for a priority area must contact the relevant person as outlined in the WA Child Research Fund *Guidelines for Applicants* to ensure the project is suitable to the service and its capacity to undertake the work.

Selection will be based on competitive merit. Projects can be awarded up to \$250,000 and must be completed within 24 months.
