

Higher degree by research (PhD) opportunity to evaluate models of care for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and youth with type 2 diabetes

We are seeking talented candidates who wish to apply for a PhD. You should ideally have a background and interest in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander child and youth health, health service delivery, models of care, provision of culturally appropriate care and qualitative research methods. This research project fits within the work of the Diabetes across the Lifecourse: Northern Australian Partnership. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples are encouraged to apply.

This qualitative PhD project will explore the appropriateness of enhanced models of care for Indigenous youth with type 2 diabetes across Northern Australia. The candidate will be required to live in Northern Australia for the duration of this project and undertake relevant cultural awareness and methodological training as required.

Eligibility:

- Enrolled in or satisfy the admission requirements for Doctor of Philosophy program at Charles Darwin University.
- Eligibility to apply for an RTP scholarship.
- Available to commence/enrol in Semester 2, 2019.
